





#### ON-TIME GRADUATION Students earning a diploma within four years. Cohort includes students who were first-time




### **School Goals**


#### REGULAR ATTENDERS Students who attended more than 90% of their enrolled school days.


#### **ON-TRACK TO GRADUATE**

Students earning a high school diploma or GED within five years. Cohort Includes students who were first-time ninth graders in 2016-17 finishing in **2020-21**.




#### **State Goals**

The Oregon Department of Education is partnering with school districts and local communities to ensure a 90% ontime, four year graduation rate by 2025. To progress toward this goal, the state will prioritize efforts to improve attendance, provide a well-rounded education, invest in implementing culturally responsive practices, and promote continuous improvement to close opportunity and achievement gaps for historically and currently underserved students.




